Year In Review: Development & Policy

Development Update

- Humber Theatre construction phase; mixed-use component appears to focus on medical uses
- ► Harcroft & Bloor approved for 8-storey mixed use condominium, Site Plan remains under review
- Quebec & Bloor (N/E corner) City accepted settlement offer from developer with revised massing and height (19 stories) on February 5, 2025

▶ Bloor West Village Avenue Study & Heritage Conservation District (HCD) Study

- City held an Open House in October 2024 to share a draft policy framework for the implementation for the Avenue Study, no date yet on presentation to Council
- ► The Bloor West HCD Study will be presented to the Toronto Preservation Board in line with reporting on the Avenue Study

Bloor Street Bike Lanes

- Bike lanes remain an important issue, as highlighted in our recent survey, and we continue to follow developments


- Continue to maintain <u>www.bwvra.ca</u> via WordPress (free)

Year In Review: Member Survey

- Sent out mid January
- ▶ **26** responses (30% hit rate high end of average)
- ▶ 92% wish to continue being member
- ▶ 78% interested in joining the Board or taking on other volunteer duties
- ▶ Top three issues: 23, 19, and 17 responses from survey participants
- Results reaffirm our focus on development
